ACADEMIC ATTAINMENT

Result of classes X and XII for the session 2023-24 was declared by CBSE on 13 May 2024. Students of class X gave a stupendous performance as they achieved 100% result (203/203). Siddharth, Saksham Chauhan and Priyanshi Chauhan secured the top positions with 96, 95.4 and 94.6 percent marks respectively. In class XII, 62,34 and 66 students appeared for Science, Commerce and Humanities stream Examination respectively and achieved 100% result. Radhika Gupta, Parth Garg and Jiya Chauhan topped the Humanities, Science and Commence stream with 97.2, 96 and 93.6 percent marks respectively. Radhika Gupta was the overall school topper in all the streams. The excellent result was a testament of relentless efforts of all the key stakeholders.

CO-SCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES

1. To foster the spirit of discovery among students and unleash their latent potential, Vidyalaya organised a diverse array of 'Activity Classes' for students of classes VI to VIII on 12 March 2025 & from 17 March 2025 to 22 March 2025. These engaging activities offered students a platform to acquire new skills, foster curiosity and cultivate mindfulness. The diverse range of activities including Chants of Serenity, Mastering the Grace, Wellness Wisdom, Digits and Delights, Ink and Impression, Creative Canvas, Active Arena and Rhythmic fusion offered a holistic learning experience which not only helped them to refine their fundamental skills but also encouraged them to reconnect with inner selves. The students had an immersive and enriching experience beyond the confines of textbooks.
2. Vidyalaya is dedicated to nurturing compassion, empathy, and values among its students that encourage them to live and let live. "Kindness Matters" is a key part of this mission. Students wholeheartedly support those deprived of basic necessities by providing clothes, books, stationery

items and more. This year, clothes and toys were distributed to the needy people in the areas of Khera Kalan, Khera Khurd, and the surrounding regions. Additionally, stationery items were presented to the Acharya of a Gurukul in Khera Kurd on 19 March 2025. The aim of this initiative is to promote the well-being of others.

3. The National Level Orange Global Olympiad of Skill Education, Reasoning and Aptitude was conducted on 10 March 2025 for the students of classes III-VIII. A total of 61 Students participated in the exam, which assessed their aptitude, values and critical thinking skills.
4. The ATL Student Internship Programme, powered by Atal Innovation Mission and IBM Skill Build, aims to equip students with essential technological and problem-solving skills. An internship programme was organized on 5th March 2025 to provide hands-on experience, fostering innovation and creativity among young minds. 5. 6. Harshit (IX J) and Shivani (IX M) participated in the Children Social Conclave held on 22 January 2025 at Gandhi Smriti, Rajghat. This event which was organised by Gandhi Smriti, brought together young students across Delhi and NCR with a total of 48 schools showcasing their projects on Sustainable Lifestyle and Climate Change. 15. Seven students of class IX appeared for MVPP Exam conducted by science Branch of DOE on 17 November 2024. 13 students were registered for the same as seven students appeared at GBSSS, Dhaka.
16. 502 students of Vidyalaya participated in the National Science Olympiad conducted by SOF on 12 November 2024. 131 students from classes I to V, 171 students from classes VI-VIII and 200 students from classes IX - XII appeared for the examination.
17. Indian Oil Corporation Limited in association with The Times of India organised 'Indian Oil Science Quiz 2.0' on 11 November 2024 in Pearey Lal Bhawan, New Delhi. Vidyalaya team (Hridyansh Tyagi (IX M) and Harshit (IX J) participated in the same.

15. Geetansh (IX R), Shivani (IX M), Devansh (XI J) and Kumar Harish (XI J) under the mentorship of Ms. Sangeeta Nain (PGT Psychology) attended, the Adolescent Peer Education Life Skills Leadership Program, an online training session organised by CBSE, on 22-23 July 2024 and 25-26 July 2024.

16.A webinar focused on enhancing mathematical proficiency to achieve four times greater speed and accuracy in Mathematics was organised by Mr. Neelkantha Bhanu Prakash, renowned as the fastest human calculator, on 20 July 2024. A total of 250 registered students from classes I - IX, along with their parents and Mathematics faculty members, attended the webinar.

17.An engaging English webinar was organized on 29 June 2024 for students in classes II – VII. The event was curated by renowned educators, Ms. Sreedevi Gundapaneni and Mr. Neelakantha Bhanu Prakash. A total of 184 students participated in the webinar, where they learned practical tips to enhance their communication skills and boost their confidence.

18. Group Counselling sessions were held for each section of various classes on different topics in the months of April and May. The purpose of these sessions is to sensitise children regarding different aspects affecting their psycho- social wellbeing.

19.Jain Bharati Mrigavati Vidyalaya in collaboration with Times NIE organised a workshop on Career Guidance and Counselling for the students of class X on 10 April 2024. The resource person, Ms Jayshree Mehta guided students on how to choose a career for themselves.

20.An interactive session of students who had cleared compartment examination (class IX) was held with Vice Principal in ATL on 10 April 2024. Sixteen students participated in the interaction. They were addressed and motivated by the Vice Principal. They were also advised to be more focused and work harder to come out with flying colours in Class X.

21.An interactive session of Vidyalaya Principal with the new students of classes VI-IX was held in ATL on 4 April 2024. Students were asked about how they feel in the new environment. They were also encouraged to share their experiences and problems, if any with their respective class teachers, academic co-ordinators, Sr. In charge, Vice Principal or Vidyalaya Principal. 29 students participated in this session.

PARENTS

1.An online orientation session was held on March 29, 2025, for the parents of Class III students to discuss the significant transitions occurring as children move from the foundational stage to the next level of learning. The session aimed to familiarize parents with these changes and to ensure a smooth academic transition for their children. A total of 120 parents attended the session, during which several key points were discussed, including the reshuffling of sections, the transition from a mother-teacher system to a class teacher and subject teacher system, the house system, Sanskar Samvardhan, PFOG, the examination pattern, the school diary as an effective means of communication, and the role of parents. The session provided valuable insights into the academic and structural changes, fostering a collaborative approach to the holistic development of students.

2.On 29 March 2025, Vidyalaya organized an online orientation program for Class VI students and their parents to familiarize them with the school's ideology and functioning. A total of 95 parents participated in the session, which covered the academic structure, infrastructure, rules,

assessment patterns, and co-curricular activities. The orientation successfully bridged the gap between students, parents, and the school, ensuring a smooth transition into the new academic session.

3. CBSE organised a youtube live session on 28 March 2025 to gain insights into the parenting calendar's objectives. The audience were enlightened about the role of this calendar in strengthening parent-school collaboration and student well-being initiatives. It was a learning experience to know about the calendar and its role in nurturing and supporting the educational system.

4. PTMs were organised on 12 March 2025 & 24 March 2025 for the parents of students of classes VIII , IX & XI and Nursery to VII respectively to share the Annual Result. Parents collected the result and confabulated with the teachers of their wards regarding their performance. They discussed strategies to improve the performance of their wards in the next session.

5. Vidyalaya Principal held an online interactive session with the parents of students of classes VIII, IX and XI on 11 March 2025 regarding the annual result. She articulated that we should focus on making our children good human beings rather than measuring their success through marks. She emphasized that parents and teachers play a crucial role and a child's result is directly proportional to the amount of efforts put in by them. She further guided them to focus on the importance of embracing the outcome of the results with a balanced perspective, encouraging both parents and students to reflect on the journey rather than just the destination.

6. A meeting of Examination committee with the Vidyalaya Principal was conducted on 22 February 2025 for discussing Promotion Rules for classes Nursery to IX and XI for the session 2024-25. The promotion rules as per Guidelines issued by DOE dated 07 October 2022 and promotional policy for late admission, medical cases and absentees during the Annual Examination were discussed. The Principal guided that a meeting of absentees should be conducted to apprise the students about the importance of examination. The same should be conveyed/highlighted during Orientation Programme in the coming session. The meeting was attended by Vidyalaya Principal, Senior Incharge, Dr. Abhishek Saini -Vice Chairman-PTA, Primary Incharge, Examination Incharge and members of Examination Committee.

7. The Parent-Teacher meeting was organised by the Vidyalaya for the parents of classes Nursery to XII on 25 January 2025 to review their ward's academic performance.

8. A parent teacher meeting was held on 31 December 2024 for the parents of students of classes Nursery to X. Parents interacted with teachers to discuss their wards' academic progress, strengths, and areas of improvement.

9. An offline interactive session was held for the parents of late bloomers of class X with the Vidyalaya Principal on 13 December 2024. Academic performances of the students were discussed.

10. An interaction session of late bloomers' parents of class X with the Vice Principal of the Vidyalaya was held on 30 November 2024. Parents of 12 students attended the session in the Vidyalaya. Academic performance of the students was discussed. Tips on monitoring students

were shared by the Vice Principal.

11. A short interaction of Vidyalaya Principal with the late bloomers of class VIII was held on 29 January 2025. Total 25 Students from the five sections of class VIII received guidance on the importance of hard-work, focus and dedication towards studies.
12. An offline interactive session was held for the parents of late bloomers of class X with the Vidyalaya Principal on 13 December 2024.
13. An interaction session of late bloomers' parents of class X with the Vice Principal of the Vidyalaya was held on 30 November 2024. Parents of 12 students attended the session in the Vidyalaya. Academic performance of the students was discussed. Tips on monitoring students were shared by the Honourable Vice Principal. Parents were requested to send their wards to Vidyalaya regularly.
14. Offline Interactive Sessions were held for parents of students of Class XII (Late Bloomers) on 29 and 30 November 2024. 16 parents visited the Vidyalaya. The Interaction was done by Vice-Principal, Senior Incharge and Academic Co-ordinator (XI-XII). The academic performance of their wards was discussed and parents were guided to send their wards to school on a regular basis after the Pre- board exams.
15. An online interactive session of Vidyalaya Principal with Parents of students of classes Nursery to XII was held on 13 November 2024 on the significance of the School Health and Wellness Programme.
16. A Parent-Teacher Meeting was held on 9 October 2024, for the parents of students of classes Nursery to XII. The primary focus of the meeting was to share the Mid-Term Examination result. Parents interacted with teachers to discuss their ward's academic progress, strengths, and areas for improvement.
17. Vidyalaya organised a virtual interactive session for parents of students of classes Nursery to XII with the Vidyalaya Principal on 8 October 2024.
