(without aid) w.e.f. academic session 1988-89.

Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject noted above, I am directed to grant recognition to your school from class Ist to VIII (without aid) w.e.f. 1988-89 session subject to the fulfilment of the following terms & conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Edn. Act & Rules, 1973 framed thereunder as well as the students issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed and preference shall be given to the students of East, Bhajanpura Area.
3. That the school shall appoint full time qualified and eligible for all the classes of the schools as per the present norms of the department and unqualified staff shall be replaced.
4. That the provisions of sec.10(i) of DSEA, 73 shall be fulfilled.
5. That the school shall equip the science Lab. as per the norms of the department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students. More material worth Rs.5000/- shall be purchased in Dec., 1988 a list be furnished to the E.O. for verification.
6. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student may be added and facilities and the list of books worth Rs.5,000/- may be purchased in Dec., 1988 verification.
7. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.
8. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education ACT & Rules, 1973 and payment shall be made as per section 10(i) of DSEA, 73 and to all employees.
9. That the enrolment in each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @12 sq.ft. per student for the available floor area of the class room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Edu., Delhi in each class. Number of the existing sections should not exceed the number of the class-room of proper size in the school.
10. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.

11. That the services contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
12. That all the facilities prescribed under Rule 50 & 51 of the RSEP, 1973 shall be made available to the students. Provision of Rules 6, 7 & 9 be strictly observed.
13. That the arrangement of good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to the Teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health certificate may be obtained from the Local Body within a month.
14. That the management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs.5000/- (Rupees five thousand) only, in a Joint Account in the name of the Director of Edn. and the Manager of the school in any scheduled bank within a month.
15. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions rules & regulations of the department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.
16. That the class IX shall not be opened without the prior approval of the Director of Edn., Delhi.
17. That a report about the fulfilment of the above conditions giving the extent to which each condition is fulfilled shall be sent to the Education Officer every six months.

Sub: Upgradation of School from Middle to Secondary level
w.e.f. academic session 1991-92 (without aid).

Madam,

With reference to your application dated 16-1-1990 on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi Administration, Delhi, for the upgradation of the existing middle school to Secondary level with effect from the academic session 1991-92 subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions :-

1. That the School shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the School shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. That the School will meet the additional liability of Secondary classes.
4. That the School shall establish and equip all the science labs as per the norms of the department/CBSE and also purchase more material by March, 1992 and a list be furnished to DDE (Science) for verification.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student may be added and more books shall be purchased for senior classes.
6. That more sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students by March, 1992 and a list of the same be furnished to E.O. for verification.
7. That the School shall strictly abide by the provisions of section 10(i) of the Delhi School Education Act & Rules 1973 and payment shall be made through crossed cheques.
8. That the Enrolment of each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq. ft. per student for the available floor area of the class-room and the School shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per norms of the Directorate of Education in each class. Number of sections should not exceed the number of existing class-rooms of proper size in the School and each class-room, science lab., and library rooms may be fitted with proper electrical appliances.
9. That the School shall not run unrecognised classes for any other activities within the School premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place at the above address only. Nursery classes be removed from the premises of the School immediately. That the School shall obtain the fresh Health Certificate from the M.C.D.

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10. That the School shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
11. That the service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
12. That all the facilities prescribed under Rules 50 & 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
13. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be available to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately.
14. That the management of the School shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) in the name of the Director of Education and the Manager of the School.
15. That the violation of any instructions/orders/ conditions/rules and regulations of the department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the School.
16. That the School society shall obtain additional land from the DDA and will construct the building as per the specifications of the department within a period of two years.
17. That the provident fund, family pension and group insurance benefits of the employees payable to the employees of a recognised private school shall be made available to the employees of the School. These benefits shall not be less than those of the employees of the corresponding status in schools run by the appropriate authority and recommendations of IVth Pay Commission shall be implemented strictly and report to the E.O.

Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi for the upgradation of the existing Secondary School to Senior Secondary level without aid u.s.g. session 1993-94 subject to the fulfilment of the following terms & conditions :-

1. That the School shall abide by the provisions of the Delhi School Education Act & Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the School shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. That the School shall meet the additional liability of senior secondary classes.
4. That the School shall purchase adequate science equipment and apparatus as per the norms of CBSE/ Education Department for Senior Secondary classes and also purchase more material by March '94 and list will be furnished to Dy. Director (Science) for verification.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student shall be purchased and made available to the students.
6. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students and more material shall be purchased by March '94.
7. That the School shall strictly abide by the provision of Section 10(1) of the Delhi School Education Act rules '73.
8. The staff shall be paid full salary from the date of the recognition and the proof should be shown to the concerned Education Officer.
9. That the School shall not run any unrecognised classes or any other activities within the School premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place at the above address only. Nursery classes be removed from the premises of the School immediately, if any.

10. That the School shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
11. That the service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
12. That all the facilities prescribed under Rule 50 and 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
13. Proof of the effect that qualified staff has been appointed as per recruitment rules be provided for verification.
14. That the staff has been paid all arrears upto date & being paid as per 4th Pay Commission. Proof to be given to E.O. for verification.
15. That the arrangements for good drinking water shall be made to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the Local Body within a month.
16. That the management of the School shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only).
17. That the violation of any instructions, orders/ conditions/rules and regulations of the department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the School.
18. That the School shall comply with norms of the CBSE for affiliation for examination purposes.
19. That Provident Fund, Family Pension and Group Insurance Benefits payable to the employees shall be at par with those payable to the employees of a recognised private school. The benefits shall not be less than those of the employees of the corresponding status in the School run by the appropriate authority and recommended by the 4th Pay Commission shall be implemented strictly and reported to the E.O.
20. That report about the fulfilment of the above conditions shall be sent to the Education Officer every six months.
